## Quiz Competition Format - Nani A. Palkhivala Memorial Quiz Competition

## This is the tentative format for the quiz competition:

## - Basic Rules:

1. Only team entries are allowed, and team shall consist of two persons. There is not limit of teams from single institution.
2. The decision of the quiz-master will be final and will not be subjected to any change.
3. The participants shall not be allowed to use mobile or other electronic instruments during the quiz time.
4. The questions shall be in the form of multiple choice, true/false statement, specific answer question etc.
5. Audience/Supporters shall not give any hints or clues to the competitors.
6. Replacement of any participant of a team is not allowed after registration.

## - Rounds

1. Preliminary round or elimination round.
2. Final round or stage round.

- Preliminary round:

1. Each team will be given a set of question paper containing 25 multiple choice objective type questions. The following rules will be application for the preliminary round.
2. Time limit: 25 minutes.
3. Each question will carry 1 mark.
4. Only top 6 teams will be selected for final or stage rounds.
5. In case of tie between 2 or more teams, further 5 questions will be asked for final selection. This step will be continued till the selection of 6 teams.
6. The selected teams shall have to appear for the final round.

- Stage Round (Nani A. Palkhivala Round)

The Top 6 teams will appear for the stage round. The following rules will be applicable (to be finalised by the Quizmaster):

Stage 1: Every team will get a chance to answer the question presented to them. If they are unable to answer the question, they can pass the question to the next team. There will be no negative marking in this round.

Stage 2: Every team will get a chance to answer the question presented to them. If they are unable to answer the question, they can pass the question to the next team. There will be negative marking in this round.

Stage 3: The following rules will be application for the final round:

1. 10 marks will be awarded for correct answer.
2. Response time for each question is 30 seconds.
3. There is not pass option.
4. Team discussion is allowed.
5. In the rapid-fire round, each team will be asked 3 question one after another. 10 marks will be awarded for the correct answer and 5 marks will be deducted for each wrong answer
