

MMXC EQUAL OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIPS

1. OBJECTIVE

The MMXC Equal Opportunity Scholarships have been started by alumni of NUJS who believe that the 5 years they spent at NUJS were some of the best years of their life. The objective of the scholarships is to reduce financial burden on students so that they can also graduate with great experiences and fond memories of life at NUJS.

The scholarships will be broadly granted based on a combination of the following factors:

- Merit: academic potential and excellence.
- Need: income, scholarships, loan debt, family contributions, etc.
- Diversity: socio-economic status, first-generation college graduate, underrepresented minorities, etc.

Students are encouraged to apply even if they meet some (and not all) of the above criteria.

2. NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS AND AMOUNT

- a. During any academic year at NUJS, there will be 3 scholarships of INR 100,000 each.

3. ELIGIBILITY

- a. The scholarships apply only for the 5 years integrated B.A. LL.B. course. Any student from years one to five of the NUJS B.A. LL.B. Programme is eligible to apply.

4. APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- a. Applications should be submitted **only by email to Anusha at mmxc.fund@gmail.com**.
- b. The application should include:
 - i. A cover letter/statement of purpose, preferably of no more than one page, which shall make out a case for the award of the scholarship (based on the criteria for the scholarship, overall academic performance and demonstrated economic need).
 - ii. Students who have availed scholarship/financial assistance from any source (including college) should declare the amount of scholarship/financial assistance in the cover letter. **Please note that we will check with the administration to confirm the veracity of statements made.**

- iii. A brief article (no more than 500 words) analysing a concept relating to any field of law.
- iv. A curriculum vitae of no more than two pages.
- v. Letter from NUJS certifying that the applicant is a student enrolled in the NUJS B.A. LL.B. programme.
- vi. Photocopy of the marksheet / CGPA scores of all previous academic years/semesters, attested by NUJS.
- vii. Photocopy of Class 12 Board exam marksheet and the CLAT rank (applicable only to applicants from the first year of the NUJS B.A. LL.B. programme).
- viii. Any other document that would make out a case for the scholarship.

In addition to the above, the applicants may be required to submit further documents that we may request.

Students will be shortlisted based on the information submitted. Shortlisted students will need to participate in a short interview.

Please note that the selection of the successful candidate under this scholarship is solely at our discretion.

5. PERIOD OF SUBMISSION

- a. For the academic year 2022-2023, the final date for receipt of the application is, **January 31, 2023**. The selection of the successful candidates will be completed by **20 February 2023**.
